Please let Steve Overton, our CAP President know your feelings as soon as possible, and he'll let Doug know which date we'd like.

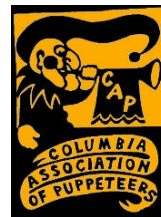
PuppetGanza 3, the Halloween Special, comes to The Nocturnal Sunday October 31st!
