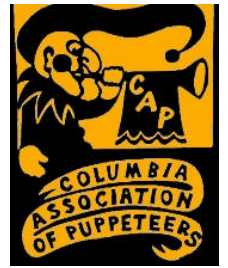

# **PERSEUS!!!**



This is the tale of how a boastful, impulsive youth evolves into one who is brave and wise. Aided by the goddess Athena, Perseus sets out to find Medusa and, in the course of this adventure, helps the giant Atlas and rescues Princess Andromeda from a terrible sea monster. It features a combination of Bunraku puppets, marionettes and masked puppeteers. Construction of the puppets and masks for *Perseus* began in April, 2001 by the Olde World Puppet Theatre, and lasted all summer. You can follow the building of the puppets in the workshop

It is a collection of fascinating, funny, and sometimes poignant images that cannot be labeled or categorized, but merely hinted at as WHATNOT. The performance is inter-active. A group of objects from which the audience chooses activates each piece in the performance. Recommended for 14 years of age and over.
