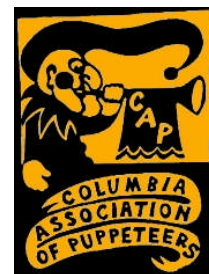

**CAP's July Gathering: at Esther Heydt's House

7030 SW Gable Pkwy, Portland (Raleigh Hills) OR
Theme: Oriental Puppets**



Two Ways to get to Esther Heydt's House:

- 1: Take SW BEAVERTON HILLSDALE HWY.
- 2: In Raleigh Hills, Turn RIGHT onto SW OLESON RD. 37 feet
- 3: Turn RIGHT onto SW SCHOLLS FERRY RD.
0.5 miles
- 4: Turn LEFT onto SW RALEIGHWOOD LN. 0.2 miles
- 5: Turn RIGHT onto SW 70TH AVE. 0.1 miles
- 6: Turn LEFT onto SW GABLE PKWY. 0.1 miles

OR

- 1: Take US-26 WEST towards BEAVERTON.
- 2: Take the exit, exit number 71B, towards SYLVAN.
0.2 miles
- 3: Turn LEFT onto SW SKYLINE BLVD. 0.0 miles
- 4: Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto SW SCHOLLS FERRY RD
1.2 miles
- 5: Turn RIGHT onto SW GABLE PKWY. 0.4 miles

Robin Hood Puppets Come to Life
at Sherwood (OR) Robin Hood Days

This year's Robin Hood festival is very different for *The Olde World Puppet Theatre*.

Instead of performing a piece from its vast repertoire as in previous years, the theatre has created a Robin Hood Spectacular, designed by Dan DeMoy, just for Sherwood, commemorating the Robin Hood Festival's 50th birthday.

"We have never designed and built a show specifically for a festival that the festival will own," said Steven Overton, master puppeteer. "It's a real gift of love to the city of Sherwood."

DeMoy, Overton, and Marty Richmond, and a crew of helpers have been busy creating the puppet extravaganza, which will feature eight-foot tall stained glass-type windows. Characters from four Robin Hood legends will pop out of the windows and come to life above the audience, while a monk narrates four tales.

The puppeteers have been working on the show for two months, and DeMoy estimates that they will hand-cut 2,000 pieces of plastic for the windows and characters.

Sherwood is a short 25-minute drive from Portland down Highway 99. The show will be held twice at the family stage - 7:15 pm on Friday and 2:15 pm on Saturday.

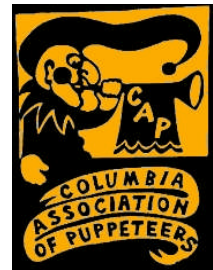
