**DIRECTIONS:** From Vancouver, take I-5 South to the first exit after crossing the Columbia river into Oregon. The mall will be right in front of you. Circle right, around the North end of the mall, and continue to the west end of the parking lot, next door to Toys R Us. From Portland, take I-5 North to the 308 Exit, the last exit before entering Washington. Circle left, crossing under the freeway to the West side where the mall is located. Scream at the Beach is located at the west end of the parking lot, next door to Toys R Us.



Scream at the Beach's story begins just a short time ago in 1991 when a Thematic Designer named Henry Miller, owner of TW Productions LLC, opened his first Halloween haunt in Portland. Rated the number one haunted event its first year, the intense theming afforded guests a chance to take a trip to a place that previously only existed in their imagination.

Scream at the Beach was joined in year two by Dave Helfrey, creator of Baron Von Gooloo's Museum of Horrors, and with two more haunts created by TW Productions, Scream at the Beach grew from one to four attractions in 2002.

Thousands flocked to Scream at the Beach when it first opened and year two saw a doubling of guest attendance. Season three had yet another increase in turnout as Dave Thomblason arrived with his Theater Macabre, making Scream at the Beach the largest collection of Halloween haunts in the Region. Now entering its fourth season, the event is expanding to fill two more stores at the mall, and large animated monsters are being added to the collection of surprises.
